The students will remain anonymous throughout the survey process. In SSS there would be Seventeen questions all over and out of which, fourteen questions would be objective type and three question provides opportunity for the students to give their observations /suggestions in a descriptive way to improve the overall teaching – learning experience in our institution.

The questionnaire covers a wide array of skills involved in the teaching process which vary from teaching skills of the teacher, technical knowledge, effectiveness of communication, preparedness, doubt clearing skills and use of ICT, to overall approach to the educational process like motivation, interpersonal relationships, feedback, dynamically improving teaching learning process and so on. The Questionnaire is based on the Likert scale on a graded marking system. The students' response is based on a scale 0 to 4. Highest positive response is rated as 4 and the lowest negative response is rated as 0. This provides a more comfortable wider range for students to register their opinion. This fetched response from students was recorded and performance of stakeholders were analyzed with regards to the feedback provided.

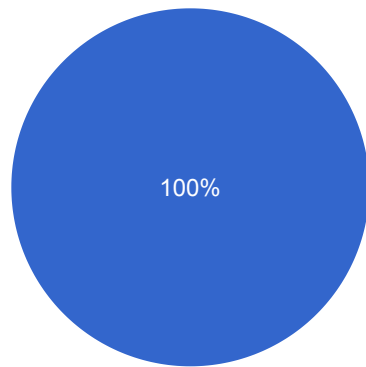
